At the end of the course, graduates will be able to...

CO1	Demonstrate adequate knowledge about the various categories of materials used in dentistry along with its properties.
CO2	Demonstrate adequate knowledge about the indications and applications of various dental materials and to manipulate and utilize dental materials for chair side and laboratory procedures.
CO3	Apply knowledge of the pharmacology of the major drugs and drug classes currently used in medical practice.
