## COLLEGE DISCIPLINE RULES

- Every student shall maintain strict discipline in the College premises.
- The Student shall always maintain decency, decorum and etiquette and shall behave with other students in proper manner.
- **Dress Code:** All students should abide by the uniform prescribed by the institution.
- **For Boys:-** Boys students must come with clean shaven face, uniform and shoes and their shirt tucked in. Jeans, T-shirts, sneakers/tennis shoes, Hawai chappals and garish coloured clothes should not be worn to College/Hospital. Finger nails should be kept short and trimmed regularly.
- **For Girls :-** Girls should wear prescribed uniform and should have their hair properly tied up. They are not allowed to leave the hair loose. Girls are expected to refrain from wearing short kurtis. Wearing jeans pants, T- shirts, sleeveless tops and tight leggings is strictly prohibited. Wearing Dangling Earrings is not allowed. Finger nails should be kept short and trimmed regularly and avoid wearing nail polish.
- Both boys and girls should wear clean white aprons with the college emblem in the campus premises. They should have name plates, ID Cards on their aprons. To respect the sanctity of profession please do not wear these aprons outside the college campus.
- The student shall obey the instructions of the Faculty members, patients and shall always interact with them with due respect.
- No student shall take part in any undesirable activity like RAGGING or involve himself/herself in any political or other movements in any manner during the course of study in the college.
- Students are not allowed to possess / use their cellular phones and pagers inside the classrooms, canteen, campus, hospital and examination halls.
- Students shall devote their whole time for their studies and should maintain steady progress.
- Every candidate should have minimum 85% attendance of the total classes conducted in Theory / Practical / AETCOM / clinical separately.
- It is mandatory for all the students to attend all the internal assessments conducted by the college; otherwise they will not be allowed to take university examination.
- Any candidate who fails to pass the formative assessments / internal assessments or annual examination of the University as prescribed shall have the course extended according to the regulations of the concerned courses of study and such candidates shall have to pay tuition fee and other fees for such extended duration of the course also.



## **COLLEGE DISCIPLINE RULES**

- If any candidate has to discontinue his/her course of study for any reason, at any time after one month from the date of admission; such candidate shall have to remit the entire fees prescribed for the full duration of the course to which he/ she is admitted to, before leaving the college. Under no circumstance, fees once paid to the college account shall be refunded.
- The student should make good use of the apparatus, furniture or any other articles belonging to the College. The management cannot tolerate damages to the college property due to negligence, carelessness or deliberately on behalf of the students. The cost of such damage will be recovered along with fine from the students as determined by the college disciplinary committee and this will not be adjusted with the caution deposit.
- Failure on the part of the students to keep up with the disciplinary rules will result in such punishment including expulsion from the college as may be imposed by the college disciplinary committee.
- The decision of the college disciplinary committee with regard to disciplinary cases shall be final and all the students shall abide by such decision of the college disciplinary committee.
- Issues pertaining to female concerns can be directly addressed to women's cell headed by Internal Complaints Committee (ICC).
- Migration during clinical courses of study shall not be allowed on any grounds as per National Medical Commission Norms.

### **Penalties and Punishments**

The disciplinary authority may at his discretion inflict punishment where the misconduct has been proved.

Major/Serious punishments and penalties will be published in the College notice board.

## **HOSTEL DISCIPLINE RULES**

- All hostellers of the Hostel shall observe the following rules for the smooth and efficient running of the Hostel for their comfortable stay.
- Only bonafide students of VIMS & RC are eligible for admission to the Hostel.
- Hostellers should not change the room allotted to them without the permission of the Warden concerned.
- The hostel management will provide each hosteller a cot, table, chair and a cupboard. The hostellers have to bring mattress, pillow, bucket, mug and other essential toiletries on their own.
- No posters or pictures should be stuck either inside or outside the room or anywhere around the premises of the Hostel or College. Hostellers should avoid sticking bills and posters on the window, doors and walls (except nameplates on the room door). In case the room is not in order fine will be levied on the erring student.
- Hostellers are responsible for proper and careful use of furniture and fixtures provided in the rooms and hostel premises.
- Tampering with fixture and electrical connections are strictly forbidden.
- No damage to property of the Hostel should be caused by any student. The cost of such damage will be recovered along with fine from the hostellers as determined by the college council and this will not be adjusted with the caution deposit.
- Possession and usage of mobile phones is permitted in the hostel room only. But the students cannot use the mobile phones outside their hostel rooms even in the mess, corridors and in common areas. Laptops and iPads are permitted inside the hostel premises for academic purpose, in case of violation authorities reserve the right to check and take appropriate action.
- Hostellers shall switch off fans and lights before leaving their rooms.
- No guests or day scholars are permitted to stay in the hostel room without prior permission from the Resident Warden concerned.



## **HOSTEL DISCIPLINE RULES**

- Audio sets with earphones only are permitted for use by the students in the hostel premises.
- The hostellers are advised to close the taps after use in order to avoid wastage of water.
- Waste is to be disposed off only in the dustbins provided and if this rule is violated, the entire floor occupants will be fined.
- Hostellers shall eat in the mess and there will be no room service.
- Whenever any hosteller falls sick the same should be reported to the Warden, who will provide all necessary assistance to get appropriate treatment or medicines.
- Hostellers are not allowed to leave or enter the hostel after 8.00 p.m. everyday.
- Any student who wants to go out of the campus should obtain prior permission from the Chief Warden and they should return back before 8.00 p.m. No student will be allowed to enter the hostel after 8.00 p.m.
- Guardian: Parents should identify the Guardian by affixing the photo of Guardian by the parents for all purposes.
- Parents should disclose about chronic illness/ hyper sensitivities / allergies if any suffered by their ward to the warden concerned before admission to the hostel. The college disciplinary committee decision is final if any student is considered unfit / dangerous to stay in the hostel because of the above problems.
- To leave the hostel premises, permission of the Chief Warden is absolutely necessary. Prescribed format will be available at the hostel to apply for permission. Student who wants to stay overnight to visit their parents or guardians should approach the Chief Warden for permission. Permission will be granted only after talking to the guardians/parents over the phone. Such permissions shall be allowed only once in a month. {Parents are requested not to disturb their wards asking for permission to stay outside during working days of the college except emergencies, then such permissions are to be obtained after consultation with concerned Principal}
- A register will be maintained in each block to record the details of permission granted.
- All rooms, corridors, toilets etc. must be kept clean and any student who violates the rule shall be dismissed from the hostel.
- Hostellers shall keep their area noise free.
- All complaints regarding toilets, water and power supply should be made to Resident Warden through the book of complaints.



## **HOSTEL DISCIPLINE RULES**

- Laptops & computers, Electric Iron Boxes, Electric stoves, Electric Water Heating coils are not permitted for use by hostellers in the hostel premises.
- Hostellers will not be permitted to keep vehicles.
- Visitors shall only be allowed between 4.30 PM to 7.30 PM to the Hostel's visitor room after making the due entries.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages, drugs and smoking inside the College and Hostel premises is strictly prohibited.
- Male hostellers should not wear shorts, Bermudas and lungis outside the hostel rooms; Female students when coming out of the rooms should wear Churidhar/Salwar/Sarees only. Sleeveless tops/ shirt are not allowed for all students.
- **Hostel accommodation would be withdrawn from those hostellers who fail consecutively twice in the university examinations.**
- Those who do not comply with the above-mentioned rules, shall be liable for punishment which may be imposed by the college Disciplinary Committee and they will be expelled from the hostel/college.



**National Medical Commission (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in  
Medical Colleges and Institutions) Regulations, 2021**

3. Definition of Ragging.—Ragging shall mean any disorderly conduct, whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

4. Actions that may constitute ragging.—The following actions shall be included but not limited to those that may constitute ragging, namely:—

(a) any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;

(b) indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student;

(c) asking any student to do any act which such the student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;

(d) any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;

(e) exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students;

(f) any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;

(g) any act of physical abuse including all variants of it, such as, sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;

(h) any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, snail-mails, blogs, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student;



(i) any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background;

(j) any act that undermines human dignity and respect through humiliation or otherwise;

(k) any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student;

(l) any other act not explicitly mentioned above but otherwise construed as an act of ragging in the letter and spirit of the definition for ragging as provided under regulations 3 and 4.

24 Institutional administrative and penal actions.—

(5) The nature of punitive actions that may be decided shall include the following, but shall not be limited to one or more of these actions

that may be imposed, as deemed fit, namely:—

(i) suspension from attending classes and academic privileges;

(ii) withholding or withdrawing scholarship or fellowship and other benefits;

(iii) debarring from appearing in any test or examination or other evaluation process;

(iv) withholding results;

(v) debarring from attending conferences, and other academic programmes;

(vi) debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc. ;

(vii) suspension or expulsion from the hostel;

(viii) imposition of a fine ranging from twenty-five thousand rupees to one lakh rupees;

(ix) cancellation of admission;

(x) rustication from the medical college or institution for a period ranging from one to four semesters;

(xi) expulsion from the medical colleges or institutions and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.

### NOTIFICATION

NEW DELHI, 2nd SEPTEMBER- 2009

#### **Ragging includes the following:**

- 6.3. "Ragging" means any conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating .or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

#### **7. Punishable ingredients of Ragging:-**

- Abetment to ragging
- Criminal conspiracy to rag
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging
- Public nuisance created during ragging
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt
- Wrongful restraint
- Wrongful Confinement
- Use of criminal force
- Assault as well as sexual offences or even unnatural offences
- Extortion
- Criminal trespass
- Offences against property
- Criminal intimidation
- Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s)
- Physical or psychological humiliation; All other offences flowing from the definition of "Ragging"

#### **9.4 Setting up of Committees and their functions:-**

**9.4.1 The Anti-Ragging Committee:-** The Anti-Ragging Committee shall be headed by the Head of the institution and shall consist of representatives of faculty members, parents, students belonging to the freshers category as well as seniors and non-teaching staff. It shall consider the recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Squad and take appropriate decisions, including spelling out suitable punishments to those found guilty.



**9.4.2 The Anti-Ragging Squad:-** 1 The Anti-Ragging Squad shall be nominated by the Head of the institution with such representation as considered necessary and shall consist of members belonging to the various sections of the campus community. The Squad shall have vigil, oversight and patrolling functions. It shall be kept mobile, alert and active at all times and shall be empowered to inspect places of potential ragging and make surprise raids on hostels and other hot spots. The Squad shall investigate incidents of ragging and make recommendations to the Anti-Ragging Committee and shall work under the overall guidance of the said Committee.

## **11. Punishments:-**

**11.1 At the institution level:** Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

11.1.1 Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges

11.1.2 Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits

11.1.3 Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process

11.1.4 Withholding results

11.1.5 Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.

11.1.6 Suspension/expulsion from the hostel

11.1.7 Cancellation of admission

11.1.8 Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters

11.1.9 Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period

11.1.10 Fine ranging between Rupees 25,000/- and Rupees 1 lakh

11.1.11 Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institutions.

Feedback is given by faculty to every intern for improvement. Remedial sessions are also given depending on the task to be yet completed by interns.

During the course of internship every intern is mandatorily rotated at VASA (Vydehi Advanced Simulation Academy) for BLS, ACLS and trauma model skill learning sessions, HICC (Hospital Infection Control Committee) protocols training and also made to participate in the CPC (Clinico Pathological conferences) and Mortality evaluation meetings regularly. They are exposed to 9 weeks of training at secondary level hospital (C V Raman Nagar General hospital) and 3 weeks of training at Vydehi Kannamangala Rural hospital as part of Community medicine postings. They are also given opportunity to rotate for few weeks in Super speciality departments as part of Medicine / Surgery / OBG postings - overall getting a comprehensive development to enter medical profession confidently.

In addition to these programs Vydehi Hospital has developed its own flagship program called Interns Capacity Building program which is held every month on second Saturday afternoon wherein Interns are made to discuss case studies (shared in advance) of common diseases required to be known for a general practitioner. At the end there would be an objective evaluation using Google forms to acknowledge the amount of impact and learning this program has made amongst Interns.
